- 3) Nos verbos terminados em "consoante + y" tiramos o "y" e acrescentamos "ied": try/ triedd
- 4) Nos verbos terminados em "consoante + vogal + consoante", dobramos a última letra e acrescentamos "Ed": stop/ stoppedped (sílabas fortes)
