### Past Continuous-was/were + verb + ing

Affirmative	Interrogative	Negative
<b><u>I was</u></b> studying	<b><u>Was</u></b> I studying?	I was <b><u>not</u></b> studying
You <b><u>were</u></b> studying	<b><u>Were</u></b> You studying?	You were <b><u>not</u></b> studying
<b><u>He was</u></b> studying	Was he studying?	He was not studying
<b><u>She was</u></b> studying	Was she studying?	She was not studying
<b><u>It was</u></b> studying	<b><u>Yes, she was</u></b>	It was not studying
We were studying	<b><u>No, she wasn't</u></b>	We were not studying
You were studying	Was it studying?	You were not studying
They were studying	Were we studying?	They were not
	Were You studying?	studying
	Were they studying?	

**Was not= wasn't/ were not= weren't**

CUIDADO:

1) quando o verbo terminar com “e” tiramos o “e” e colocamos “ing”:

Dance- dancing

**2) Se o verbo terminar com consoante + vogal+ consoante, dobramos a última letra e acrescentamos “ing” (sílabas fortes)**

Stop- stopping/listening

I work <u>ed</u> .	<b><u>Did</u></b> I work?	I <b><u>did not</u></b> work.
You work <u>ed</u> .	Did you work?	You <b><u>didn't</u></b> work.
He work <u>ed</u> .	Did he work?	He did not work.
She work <u>ed</u> .	Did she work?	She did not work.
It work <u>ed</u> .	Did it work?	It did not work.
We work <u>ed</u> .	Did we work?	We did not work.
You work <u>ed</u> .	Did you work?	You did not work.
They work <u>ed</u> .	Did they work?	They did not work.
<p><b>Work<u>ed</u></b>            Play-play<u>ed</u> (vogal + Y= não tira o “y” apenas coloca Ed)            Study-stud<u>ied</u> (consoante + y= tira o “y” e coloca “ied”)            Stop- stop<u>ped</u> (consoante+ vogal+ consoante= dobra a última letra e acrescenta “Ed” se a sílaba forte estiver dentro do cvc)            Listen- listen<u>ed</u> (cvc- mas a sílaba forte não está dentro do cvc)  <b>Dance-danc<u>ed</u>= já termina com “e” então só acrescenta o “d</b></p>

**Past:** A lot of crimes **could** be prevented in Brazil

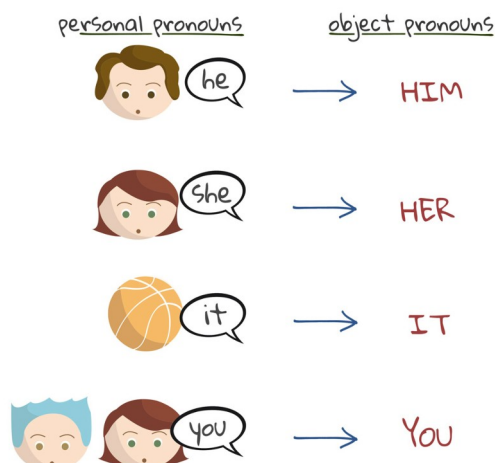
