How **good** are you at soccer? **I** am very **good/bad**. (good/bad- adjectives- um adjetivo descreve uma pessoa, um animal ou uma coisa)

How **well** do you **play** soccer? I **play** soccer **well/badly** (well/badly- adverbs- um advérbio descreve como algo acontece)

Acrescentamos **LY** nos adjetivos para formar a maioria dos advérbios de modo.
