<p><b><u>To be- past (was/ wasn't/ were/ weren't)</u></b></p> <p>You <u>were</u> tired, <u>weren't</u> you?/ She <u>was</u> sick, <u>wasn't</u> she?</p>
<p><b><u>Present Perfect (have/has + 3ª forma do verbo)</u></b></p> <p>You <u>have studied</u> a lot, <u>haven't</u> you?          She <u>has worked, hasn't</u> she?</p>
<p><b><u>Future (will/ won't)</u></b></p> <p>You <u>will</u> work tonight, <u>won't</u> you?</p>
<p><b><u>Let's</u></b> go to the movies, <b><u>shall we</u></b>?</p>
<p><b><u>Imperative</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Study</u></b> every day, <b><u>will you</u></b>?/ <b><u>Don't</u></b> sleep here, <b><u>will you</u></b>?</p>

I have studied here **since** 2016. (**since**: desde)
