Future (will/ won't)

You will work tonight, won't you?

Let's go to the movies, shall we?

Study every day, will you?/ Don't sleep here, will you?

There is: Há, existe/ There are: Existem

There are good students here, aren't there?

There is a cinema in Tupã, isn't there?

Suggestion: should, shouldn't

You should study today, shouldn't you?
